- Youth Outcome Survey** measures the entire match relationship on eight categories encompassing three areas: (a) Life Skills, (b) Risk Avoidance and (c) Education. This is conducted on the first day of the match with the youth; and on the yearly anniversary date.
- Strength of Relationship** is a survey based on a 1 – 5 scale (1 = never true, 5 = always true) – higher ratings indicate higher impact – and captures data on the entire match relationship qualities predicting strength of relationship between youth and mentor. This is conducted after three months of each match with the youth and mentor, as well as on the yearly anniversary date.
